
Recruitment of Lower Grade Clerks and Tax Collector under the Port Blair Municipal Council, Port Blair.

In continuation of Press Notices and Public Notices published in the local news papers on 31/03/2017, 01.04.2017, 02.05.2017,03.05.2017,04.05.2017, 17.04.2017, 08.05.2017, 01/06/2017 & 02/06/2017, the scheme for written examination for the post of Lower Grade Clerk and Tax Collector in the Port Blair Municipal Council is as under:

- Duration of the examination will be two (2) hours. There will be 120 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), each carrying one (1) mark with total mark 120. Question will be bilingual (Hindi and English).
- The candidates will be provided with OMR Answer Sheet and Question Booklet. At the end of the examination, candidate will hand-over the OMR Answer Sheet and Question booklet to the invigilator.
- The candidate will be required to mark the correct answer against the serial number of the question in the answer sheet .Candidates giving more than one answers for a question will be awarded zero (0) mark.
- Each correct answer will be given one (1) mark. There will be negative marking of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.

The distribution of questions and marks in General Intelligence & Reasoning, General Awareness Numerical Aptitude, is as under:

| English Language: Candidates' understanding of the Basic of English language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and it correct usage etc., his/her writing ability would be tested. | 40 | 40 |
| B.General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidates' general awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Science, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline. | 40 | 40 |

C.Numerical Aptitude

This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Number, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs, Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and work etc.



There will be a single paper for all the three subjects, having Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) and candidates will be required to qualify in all the three subjects separately. The qualifying marks will be 10 in each subject and total aggregate qualifying marks will be 40. However, in case of ST candidates there will be no restriction about the qualifying mark either in each subject or in aggregate.

The date, time and venue for examination will be published in due course.

Note: Here it may be noted that for the post of 'LGC/TAX COLLECTOR' the applicants were required to ensure their eligibility for the post before submitting applications and participating in the written examination. None of the application has been scrutinized with regard to eligibility and all the applicants will be allowed to participate in the written examination. Scrutiny of applications of the shortlisted candidates only will be done after declaration of the result of written examination. If it is found that he/she is not eligible as per the Recruitment Rules, his/her candidature will be rejected irrespective of performance in the written examination.
