e- TENDER NOTICE

The Superintendent of Police (Fire Service), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Port Blair invites e-quotations in single bid format for purchase of 'V- shaped emergency light system' from the Authorized dealer / reseller / retailers **as indicated at Annexure - I**, as per the terms and conditions are stipulated below:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The terms and condition of the tenders are prescribed below for adherence by the bidders.

1. The bidders have to submit their bids in the web site "eproc.andaman.gov.in".
2. Instruction for submission of Bid online through eproc.andaman.gov.in
 - a) Bids are required to be submitted online through the website "eproc.andaman.gov.in".
 - b) Before submission of bids, bidders are advised to go through the help manual available in the home page of website "eproc.andaman.gov.in".
 - c) In case of any assistance the bidders may call the help line numbers 080-49352000/ 080-40482114/ +91-9994295433/ 03192-259027/28. The helpline numbers are also available in home page of website "eproc.andaman.gov.in".

3. SCHEDULE:

4. In case of date of opening of the tender happens to be holiday, the tender will be opened on the next working day at the same time.
5. The rates quoted in the quotation should be all inclusive of all taxes, GST etc., for articles reaching at Main Store FS HQ's, Port Blair and no price escalation shall be allowed any ground whatsoever.
6. The bidder should mandatory upload following documents, failing to which his bid will not be accepted.
 - (i) Scanned copy of EMD or MSME / NSIC for exemption of EMD with the scope of work as one of subject of registration.
 - (ii) Copy of Pan card
 - (iii) Copy of Aadhar card
 - (iv) Bank details viz. Account number, Bank name, Branch, MICR, IFSC & Mobile number.
 - (v) Undertaking that the firm has not been blacklisted, if blacklisted the period of blacklist/debarment is not running now.

7. The supplier/tenderers should mention/submit in their bidding documents i.e Tender Validity, Delivery Period etc., any over writing/cutting etc will render the tender invalid.
8. The department will not have any responsibility for hike in the price of materials/labour during the delivery period. Further the department will however take the benefit of any deduction in the price in terms of the price variation clause taking place during the period of rate contract as per GFR.
9. EMD: Except MSME registration firms, each tender should be accompanied with the EMD of Rs. 8000/- in the form of FD/ Bankers cheque in favour of the Dy. Superintendent of Police (Fire Service), A&N Islands, Port Blair. The scanned copy of EMD shall have to be uploaded in the online portal and thereafter, the original Bankers cheque / FD/ DD shall have to be submitted to the office of the Chief Fire Officer or can be dropped in the tender box (MAIN STORE) kept at the ground floor of Fire Service HQ, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Port Blair latest by 17/12/19 up to 1030 hrs. Failure to submit original FDR / Bankers cheque within the stipulated time shall result in rejection of the bid.
10. The firm to whom supply order is being placed shall supply the quantity in full.
11. The rate quoted by the firm should not exceed the MRP price.
12. The validity period of the tender should be 03 months from the date of opening of the tender. No price variation will be admissible beyond the original scheduled delivery date for defaults on the part of the supplier. The department shall have the right to place supply order with the firm as and when required during the rate validity period.
13. No escalation on any ground such as changes in fiscal policy, consumer price index, rise in duties, Taxes or any other levy etc. or any other contingency thereof shall be considered. The price quoted and finally negotiated and agreed upon shall be treated as final, and no variation in any price thereof shall be considered.
14. The firm has to provide a guarantee certificate in respect of the supplied items for a period of 01 year (from the date of issue of satisfactory inspection certificate by purchase committee). The guarantee provided should be against all manufacturing defects and substandard materials. If any defects upon substandard materials are reported by the department, tenderer shall renew/replace it within 15 days on receipt of notice to the effect at his own cost.
15. The successful bidders have to supply the items in terms of our supply order within **60 days (Sixty days)** from the date of receipt of supply order.
16. **INSPECTION:** Inspection of supplied items will be carried out by our inspection committee on receipt of stores at Fire Service (HQ), Port Blair.
17. The stores/items will be accepted only after satisfactory inspection of the item by our inspection committee and the supplier shall be liable to replace the defective part in full, free of cost immediately failing which the supply order stands cancelled.

18. **DELIVERY PERIOD:** If the stores/items are not supplied in full shape within the stipulated **period of 60 days**. The liquidated damage charges @ 0.5% per week and part thereof delay upto maximum 5% of the actual total cost of the supplied items will be deducted from the final payment for the date beyond **60 days** till the date of receipt of material at Main Store, FSHQ and incase the firm fails to supply the same beyond the L.D (Liquidated damages) the supply order stands cancelled and the Performance Security of the firm will be forfeited and legal process will be initiated against the defaulter firm.
19. **PERFORMANCE SECURITY:-** Successful bidders shall submit **Performance Security @ 10% of total value** in the shape of Call Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee in favour of Dy. Superintendent of Police (Fire Service), A & N Islands **within 15 days** on receipt of supply order by the firm safe and Performance Security should remain valid for a period of **60 days** beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including guarantee/warranty obligations. If the successful bidders fails to Performance Security above, the EMD will be forfeited to Govt. account.
20. **PAYMENT:** No advance payment will be made. Payment with necessary TDS deduction as applicable as per rule will be made on production of pre-receipted bill after satisfactory inspection of goods/items at Port Blair.
21. No part payment will be released and the payment will be made only after the receipt of satisfactory inspection certificate from the purchase committee of the department for the supplied items.
22. The tender would be regarded as cancelled, if no award of contract has been obtained till the expiry of the tender validity. No separate communication will be made in this regard.
23. In case the date of opening of tender is declared as Public Holiday, the tender shall be opened on the next working day at the same time.
24. Late and delayed tenders will not be considered and may be returned unopened to the Bidder.
24. The Supdt. of Police (Fire), reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation without assigning any reason thereof.
25. In case if the tender is not opened due to insufficient participants / tenders the bid opening time / bid validity will be extended by the issuing corrigendum in e-proc/CPP with the approval of the competent authority.
26. All disputes will be subject to the jurisdiction of the court of A & N Islands.
