4. **PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST**

The candidates who qualify physical measurement shall undergo physical endurance test as per the following standards.

- i. 01 mile race (to be completed in 7 minutes)
- ii. 04 feet High Jump (3 chances will be given).
- iii. 12 feet Long Jump (3 chances will be given).

Note: - Candidates have to qualify in each event of physical Endurance Test, otherwise they will be eliminated at that stage only.

5. TRADE TEST

The candidates who qualify in the Physical measurement and Endurance test for the post of **Fitter Electrician and Diesel Mechanic** will be required to qualify in the trade test which will include: -

Trade test for Fitter Electrician

i.	Making of switch boards	10 marks
ii.	Fixing cut outs	10 marks
iii.	Secondary battery charging	10 marks
iv.	Assembling of tube light sets	10 marks
v.	Connecting stair case switches	10 marks

Trade test for Diesel Mechanic

i.	Checking/Starting of D.G Sets	10 marks
ii.	Checking of Battery for self start	10 marks
iii.	Identification of tools	10 marks
iv.	Re-filling of Engine oil	10 marks
v.	Dismantling and installation of parts of D.G Set	40 marks

Note: -

The candidates who obtain 50% or more marks will be considered qualified in the trade test

6. WRITTEN EXAMINATION

The candidates who qualify in the trade test for the post of **Fitter Electrician** and the candidates who qualify in Physical Measurement and Physical Endurance Test for the post of **Constable (Wireless)** will take a written test as per the following scheme.

Name of Post	Paper & Marks	Syllabus
Constable (Wireless)	Paper-I (85 marks)	The question paper will cover general knowledge, reasoning, simple arithmetic, test of language and essay. The paper will be set both in English and Hindi. Candidates will have the option of answering in either language except for the portion of language paper, which will contain questions on Hindi and English both.

Fitter Electrician	Paper – A (30 marks)	The question will cover knowledge in A.C Circuits, Electrical Appliances, Magnetism and Electromagnet, use of conductors and insulators, Cell, Batteries and Transformer
	Paper – B (20 marks)	The question paper will cover English and Hindi languages, its correct usage, simple mathematics, reasoning and general knowledge on current affairs.

7. INTERVIEW

The candidates who qualify in the written test and/or trade test will be subjected to an interview. **The interview will be for 15 marks for the post of Fitter Electrician & Diesel Mechanic and 10 marks for the post of Constable (Wireless).** During the interview the overall personality, aptitude, attitude and general awareness of the candidates will be judged.

Apart from this, additional marks up to a maximum of 5 shall be awarded for achievements in Sports and NCC as follows:-

Candidates should bring all their original certificates of achievements in Sports and NCC at the time of interview.

Final list of successful candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the trade test (for Diesel Mechanic), written paper, NCC/Sports marks and interview and on the basis of vacancies.

8. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

The successful candidates shall be subjected to medical examination as given below:

- i) Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of two eyes without correction i.e. without wearing of glasses. The candidate should not have Colour Blindness.
- ii) The candidate must not have knock-knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint eyes, bow legs, inability to close either eye, inability to flex the fingers properly or any other obvious deformities.
- iii) The candidate must be in good mental and physical health and free from any physical defects likely to interfere with the efficient performance of police duties.

9. HOW TO APPLY

- i) A candidate needs to submit only one application even when applying for all posts. A candidate will indicate in the application whether he is applying for all posts or one post. Those applying for more than one posts will have to indicate the preferences in the posts applied.
- ii) The Candidates may submit their application on a plain paper in the format given below along with the **self attested** copies of certificates of age proof, OBC category, education qualification and technical qualification with **three passport size photographs** (one should be affixed in the space given in the application form and other two should be attached along with application form) **to Recruitment Cell, Atlanta Point, Port Blair on any working day with effect from 16/10/2009 to 16/11/2009.**
- iii) Acknowledgment receipt will be issued on depositing the form which should be retained by the applicant.
- iv) The application submitted to any officers other than those authorized as above mentioned, will not be accepted and no representation in this regard will be entertained. One candidate can submit only one application. If any candidate submits more than one application, his candidature will be liable to be rejected.

10. CLOSING DATE

Application form should be deposited in the above designated office latest by **1700 Hrs on 16/11/2009.**

11. INSTRUCTIONS IN GENERAL

- i) After scrutiny and acceptance of the application forms, each applicant will be issued an **Admit card**, which will be required for all stages of the recruitment. The Admit cards should be collected by the candidate from

19/11/2009 to 23/11/2009 from the Recruitment Cell, Police Head Quarter, Atlanta Point, Port Blair.

- ii) Benefit of OBC category would be given only to those Candidates who belong to the OBC category as notified by Andaman and Nicobar Administration.
- iii) Original documents (Educational qualification, Technical qualification, age proof, sports/NCC and OBC category) will be checked at the time of 'interview'. The candidates, therefore, should bring these original documents/ certificates only at the time of interview.

Note:

- i) Applications found incomplete in any form are liable to be rejected and no further correspondence will be made in this regard. No Admit Card will be issued in case the application is rejected.
- ii) Candidates failing at any stage will be eliminated at that stage only.
- iii) The candidates shall prepare for the physical endurance test and participate at their own risk. A & N Police will not be liable for any damages in the event of any injury or other casualty suffered by a candidate during the test.
- iv) The candidates who are not satisfied with the decision of the Recruitment Board about their Physical Measurements may prefer appeal in writing in the prescribed format to the appellate authority on the same day.
- v) The date, time and venue of Physical measurement, Physical Endurance test, Trade test, written test and Interview shall be communicated in due course through local newspapers, All India Radio etc.
- vi) No TA or DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the selection Process/Interview.


