- Sub: Filling up 08 (Eight) posts of Sub - Inspector (Master) and 14 (fourteen) posts of Sub - Inspector (Engine Driver) both in the pay Band PB-1 Rs. 9300-34800 + Grade Pay Rs. 4200 in A & N Police Department by transfer on Deputation/re-employment of serving /Ex-service personnel - regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the 8 (Eight) posts of Sub - Inspector (Master) and 14 (Fourteen) posts of Sub - Inspector (Engine Driver) in the pay Band PB-1 Rs. 9300-34800 + Grade Pay Rs. 4200 are proposed to be filled up on Deputation/Re-employment from amongst the eligible Officers of Central / State Govt./ UT Administration /Autonomous Organization / Public Sector Undertakings.

A) Essential requirements for Sub-Inspector (Master)

Technical Qualification required for transfer on deputation basis:-

- (a) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the present cadre/department
Or

With 5 years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 4000-6000 or equivalent in the parent cadre/department

And

- (b) Possessing First Class Master's Certificate of competency under the ISV Act, 1917 (1 of 1917) and qualify departmental trade test.

Technical Qualification required for appointment on Re-employment:-

Serving Naval/Coast Guard Personnel/ex-Naval/Coast Guard personnel at least in the rank of Petty Officers possessing minimum 15 years experience in the boat handling and navigation. Such officials will be given deputation term up to the date on which they are due for release from the Naval/Coast Guard and thereafter they may continue on re-employment. (Re-Employment up to the age of Superannuation with reference to Civil post)

The selected Naval/Coast Guard Personnel or Ex-Naval/ Coast Guard Personnel should obtain First Class Master's Certificate of Competency under the ISV Act, 1917(1 of 1917) within 3 (three) years from the date of his appointment failing which his service shall be terminated.

B) Essential Requirements for the Sub-Inspector (Engine Driver)

Technical Qualification required for transfer on deputation basis:-

- a) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre/ Department.
Or

With 5 (five) years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs. 4000-6000 or equivalent in the parent cadre/ department.

And

- b) Possessing First Class Engine driver's Certificate of Competency under the ISV Act, 1917 (1 of 1917) and qualify departmental trade test.

Technical Qualification required for appointment on Re-employment:-

Serving Naval/Coast Guard Personnel/ex-Naval/Coast Guard personnel at least in the rank of Petty Officers possessing minimum 15 years experience in Ship's Propulsion/ Machinery. Such officials will be given deputation term upto the date on which they are due for release from the Naval/Coast Guard and thereafter they may continue on re-employment. (Re-Employment up to the age of Superannuation with reference to Civil post)

The selected Naval/Coast Guard Personnel or Ex-Naval/ Coast Guard Personnel should obtain First Class Engine Driver's Certificate of Competency under the ISV Act, 1917(1 of 1917) within 3 (three) years from the date of his appointment failing which his service shall be terminated.

Terms & conditions of Appointment on deputation/Re-Employment

- 1) In addition to pay, the selected person will be entitled to DA admissible to Government servants at the Central Government Rates.
- 2) Special Compensatory Allowances as admissible under rules.
- 3) Rent free unfurnished accommodation subject to general review or House Rent Allowance in lieu thereof.
- 4) Free Sea Passage once in a year for the Govt. servant and their family members while proceeding/returning from leave in accordance with orders in force from time to time.
- 5) Leave Travel concession as admissible under rules.
- 6) Deputation allowance as admissible under rules.
- 7) The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other

organization/ department of Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years. The Maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on closing date of receipt of application.

- 8) He shall be governed by relevant rules and orders in force from time to time in respect of Government Servant of their category serving under the Andaman & Nicobar Administration.

It is requested that the post may be circulated amongst the eligible officer working in the department under your control and the application, along with the Curriculum vitae (CV) in the enclosed proforma, of those officers who could be spared in the event of their selection, duly counter signed by the present employer forwarded to the Director General of Police, A & N Islands, Port Blair - 744104 along with upto - date ACRs, Vigilance clearance and integrity certificate etc. within 40 days from the date of publication in the Newspapers.

Application of those officers against whom disciplinary/ vigilance cases are pending or contemplated need not be forwarded. The application received after the date specified and not accompanied by the above documents will not be entertained. Ex-service personnel are not required to submit ACR, but should provide supporting documents along with the curriculum vitae.

The Curriculum Vitae duly supported by documents will be assessed by the Selection Committee while selecting candidates for appointment to the post on deputation/re-employment. Call letters will be issued to the eligible candidates for deputation to appear for qualifying departmental trade test. The serving and ex-naval / Coast Guard Personnel have to appear for interview before the selection board. Date, time and Venue will be intimated to the candidates for trade test and interview and no TA/DA will be paid to them. The selected candidates have to work anywhere in Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
