

A&N POLICE RECRUITMENT NOTICE No. 01/2009
RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF RADIO TECHNICIAN, FITTER
ELECTRICIAN AND DIESEL MECHANIC IN A& N POLICE RADIO
ORGANIZATION

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for various posts in A&N Police Radio Organization. The number of Posts, scale of pay and eligibility conditions are given below: -

1. Name of Post – Radio Technician

- i) **No. of vacancies:** 3 (1 vacancy for OBC & 2 vacancies are reserved for ST candidates of A&N Islands)
- ii) **Pay Scale** – PB – 2, Rs. 9300 – 34800 + Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- (pre-revised scale 5000- 150- 8000/-)
- iii) **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

- ii) **Pay Scale** – PB- 1, Rs. 5200 – 20200 + Grade pay 1800/- (pre-revised scale of pay Rs. 2650 – 65-3300-70-4000/-)
- iii) **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

4. PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST

The candidates who qualify in physical Measurements shall undergo Physical Endurance test as per the following standards, for all the categories of posts.

Male	Female (Wherever applicable)
a) 01 mile race (to be completed in 7 minutes)	a) 0.5 mile race (to be completed in 5 minutes)
b) 04 feet High Jump (in 3 chances)	b) 03 feet High Jump (in 3 chances)
c) 12 feet Long Jump (in 3 chances)	c) 8 feet Long Jump (in 3 chances)

Note: Candidates have to qualify in each event of physical Endurance Test; otherwise they will be eliminated at that stage only.

5. TRADE TEST

The candidates who qualify in the physical endurance test for the post of Fitter Electrician and Diesel Mechanic will be required to undergo for Trade test of 50 marks for Fitter Electrician and 80 marks for Diesel Mechanic and marks would be allotted in accordance with their performance in the trade test in the following manner-

(a) **Fitter Electrician (50 Marks)**

- (i) Making of switch board - 10 Marks
- (ii) Fixing cut - out - 10 Marks
- (iii) Secondary battery charging - 10 Marks
- (iv) Assembling of tube light set - 10 Marks
- (v) Connecting stair case switch - 10 Marks

(b) **Diesel Mechanic (80 Marks)**

- (i) Checking/Starting of DG set - 10 Marks.
- (ii) Checking of battery for self starts - 10 Marks.
- (iii) Identification of tools - 10 Marks.
- (iv) Dismantling and installation of DG set - 40 Marks.
- (v) Re-filling of engine oil - 10 Marks.

Note: Only those candidates who obtain 50% or more marks will be considered qualified in the Trade Test.

6. WRITTEN EXAMINATION

(a) **Radio Technician:**

The candidates who qualify in the Physical Measurement (PM) and Physical Endurance test (PET) shall be put through the written examination. The scheme & subject for the written examination is as given below:

Syllabus:

Paper-A: In this paper, a candidate's knowledge in Basic Electronics, Digital Electronics, Power Electronics, Communication Systems, Radio waves, Antenna, basic computer, A.C theory and Microwave Engineering will be tested.

Paper-B: In this paper a candidate's understanding of English and Hindi languages, their correct usage, simple mathematics, reasoning and general knowledge will be tested.

(b) Fitter Electrician:

The Candidates who qualify in the PM/PET and trade test shall be put through the written examination. The scheme & subject for the written examination is as given below:

Syllabus:

Paper- A: In this paper, a candidate's knowledge in A.C Circuits, Electrical Appliances, Magnetism and Electromagnet, use of conductors and insulators, Cell, Batteries and Transformer will be tested.

Paper-B: In this paper a candidate's understanding of English and Hindi languages, its correct usage, simple mathematics, reasoning and general knowledge on current affairs will be tested.

7. INTERVIEW/PERSONALITY TEST

The candidates who qualify in the written Examination for the post of Radio Technician & Fitter Electrician and those who qualify in the trade test for the post of Diesel Mechanic will be subjected to interview. The interview will carry 15 marks for all the posts. General awareness, personality, aptitude, attitude and suitability of the candidates would be judged in the interview.

Apart from this, additional marks up to a maximum of 5 shall be awarded for achievements in NCC and Sports as follows.

Candidates should bring all their original certificates of achievements in NCC and Sports at the time of interview.

Final list of successful candidates shall be prepared separately for each post on the basis of the marks obtained in the written paper(s), trade test, NCC/Sports marks and interview and on the basis of the vacancies.

Date and venue for the physical Measurement/Physical Endurance Test, Trade Test, written test and Interview will be intimated in due course.

8. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

The successful candidates shall be subjected to medical examination as given below:

- i) Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of two eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses. The candidates should not have colour blindness.
- ii) The candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein, squint eyes, bow legs, inability to flex the fingers properly or any other obvious deformities.
- iii) Candidate must be in good mental and physical health and free from any physical defects likely to interfere with the efficient performance of police duties.

10. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- i) A candidate needs to submit separate application for each post applied.
- ii) The Candidates may submit their application on a plain paper in the format given above along with the **self attested** copies of certificates of age proof, ST/OBC category, NCC/Sports, educational qualification and technical qualification with two passport size photographs to the **Police Radio Officer (PHQ), Atlanta Point, Port Blair from 20/02/2009 to 09/03/2009 till 5.00 PM.**
- iii) After scrutiny and acceptance of the applications, each applicant will be issued an admit card, which will be required for all the stages of the recruitment. The admit cards should be collected by the candidate on 16/03/09 and 17/03/09 from the Office of the Police Radio Officer. In case any candidate could not collect the admit card from the PRO office, they should collect the same from Police Lines, Port Blair before the commencement of physical measurement and physical endurance test.

- iv) Photostat copies of ST/OBC certificate issued by competent authority **duly self attested** should be enclosed by candidates belonging to ST/OBC category. Benefit of ST/OBC category would be given only to those Candidates who belong to the ST/OBC category as notified by Andaman and Nicobar Administration.
- v) Original documents (Educational Qualification, Technical Qualification, age proof, ST/OBC category, N.C.C/Sports) will be checked at the time of **'Interview'**. The candidates, therefore, should bring these original documents/certificates only at the time of interview.
- vi) Applications which are incomplete and applications received after the due date will not be entertained under any circumstances and no claims in this regard shall be entertained.
- vii] Candidates who do not qualify in the Physical Measurement will be rejected. In case of any doubt about the Physical Measurement, the candidate can appeal in writing to the appellate authority.
- viii] The candidates shall prepare for the physical endurance and trade tests and participate at their own risk. A & N Police will not be liable for any damages in the event of any injury or other causality suffered by a candidate during the test.
- ix) The final list of selected candidates will be published and displayed on the Notice Boards at Police Head Quarter, Police Station Aberdeen, District SP's office, Police Lines and other selected places besides publication in local newspapers.
- x] Each selected candidate will be subjected to a medical examination and verification of character and antecedents, before offer of appointment in the A&N Police.
- xi] No TA or DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the selection Process/Interview.
- xii] Selected candidates will have to undergo basic training at PTS Police Line, Port Blair.
- xiii) Selected candidates may be posted anywhere in A & N Islands.


