Sub: Filling up of the post of **Director of Fisheries** (Group-A Gazetted) in the Department of Fisheries under the A&N Administration on deputation basis.

Sir / Madam,

I am directed to say that it is proposed to fill up One General Central Services Group 'A' (Gazetted) Non' Ministerial post of Director of Fisheries in the scale of pay in PB-3 ` 15600-39100 + Grade pay of ` 7600 in the Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration by deputation (Including short term contract).

- I. Plus promotion from amongst the officers of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territories or Universities or Recognized Research Institutions or public sector undertaking or semi-government or statutory or autonomous organizations.
 - a) (i) Holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department;

or
 - (ii) With five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the pay band-3 (PB-3) of ` 15600-39100 with grade pay of ` 6600 in the parent cadre or department; and
 - (b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

Essential:

- (i) Master's degree in Marine Biology or Zoology or Oceanography or Fisheries Science or Fisheries Management or Industrial Fisheries or Aquatic Biology in Fisheries from a recognized University or Institute;
- or*
- Post Graduate Diploma in Fisheries Science of the Central Institute of Fisheries Education, Mumbai.
- (ii) Ten years' experience in the field of Inland and Marine Fisheries including experience of implementing plan schemes and centrally sponsored schemes relating to Marine or Inland Fisheries or Coastal Aquaculture.

Desirable: Doctorate in Fisheries Science.

- II. The Departmental Joint Director in the pay band 3 (PB-3) of Rs. 15600-39100 with grade pay of Rs. 6600 with five years' regular service in the grade will also be considered alongwith outsiders and in case he is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

Note1: The departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note2: Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department or the Central Government shall ordinary not to exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short term contract) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note3: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.

- III. The candidates from Central/State Governments/UT Administrations/Universities/Recognized Research Institute/Public Sector Under takings/Semi-Government/Statutory/Autonomous organizations should clearly indicate whether the scale of pay held by them is on Central DA Pattern or Industrial Pattern.

IV. Terms and Conditions of appointment are as under:

- (a) During the period of deputation he/she will have the option either to get his/her pay fixed in the deputation post under the operation of the normal rules or to draw pay of the post held by him/her in his/her parent department plus deputation(duty) allowance in accordance with and subject to the condition, as modified from time to time and such other general or special orders issued by the Govt. of India;

- (b) In addition to the pay, the selected officer will be entitled to Dearness Allowance at Central Govt. rates.
- (c) Special Compensatory Allowance at flat rate as admissible under the orders of the Govt. of India.
- (d) He/She will be entitled to T.A and joining time both on joining the post on deputation and on reversion from this Administration under the rules of the borrowing department to which he is deputed. The expenditure on this account will be born by the borrowing department.
- (e) Free Sea Passage once in a year for self and family members while proceeding to/returning from leave in accordance with the orders in force from time to time.
- (f) Leave Travel Concession as admissible under the rules.
- (g) Unfurnished residential accommodation subject to general review from time to time or House Rent Allowance in lieu thereof.
- (h) Deputation Allowance as admissible under the rules.
- (i) Tenure – initially for 1(one) year, but may be extended upto a maximum three years.
- (j) The deputation will commence on the date on which he/she assumes charge of the post under the Administration.
- (k) In respect of matters not specified above, the selected officer shall be governed by rules and orders in force from time to time in respect of Government servants of his category serving under the A&N Administration.

V The Duties and Responsibilities attached to the post are as under: -

He is the Head of Department for the purpose FR & SR and Head of organization for the Directorate. He provides guidance and leadership to Officers and staff employed in the department of Fisheries. He coordinates works between various sections like Marine Fisheries, Inland Fisheries, Coastal Aquaculture, Civil Works, implementation of Departmental plan schemes and centrally sponsored schemes throughout the Islands. He shall acts as a Liason Officer with the Administration and other Departments. He is responsible for executing all the plan and non-plan activities of the Department. He shall act as Adjudicating Officer under A & N Islands Marine Fishing Regulations, 2003 and A & N Marine Fishing Rules 2004 effectively and State public information officer under Right to Information Act-2006. He is also responsible for dealing with policy matters.

VI It is requested that the post may be circulated amongst the eligible Officers working under your control and the **applications (in duplicate)**, alongwith the Curriculum Vitae (CV), in the enclosed Performa, of those Officers who could be spared in the event of their selection, duly countersigned by the present employer, alongwith xerox copies of ACRs/APARs for the last 5 years (duly attested), Vigilance Clearance and Integrity Certificate etc., duly forwarded through proper channel, should reach the address given below **within 60 days from the date of issuance of this Circular** in a sealed envelope superscribing "**Application for the post of Director of Fisheries**".
